DANGEROUS SITUATIONS IN ADVERSE WEATHER & SEA CONDITIONS



- 1. Dangerous phenomena in following and quartering seas:
- Surf-riding and broaching-to
- Reduction of intact stability when riding a wave crest amidships
- Parametric roll motions
- Sailing with the group velocity of waves
- Combination of various dangerous phenomena
- 2. Dangerous phenomena in head and bow seas:
- Damage from slamming and shipping of water
- Parametric roll motions
- 3. Dangerous phenomena in beam seas:
- Synchronous rolling motion
- Capsizing in a steep or breaking wave
- 4. Severe wind and rolling criterion (weather criterion)
- 5. IMO Revised guidance to the master for avoiding dangerous situations in adverse weather and sea conditions
